CAN YOUR NON-PROFIT GET A BOOST FROM BSO?

Sheriff Scott Israel is pleased to announce that the Broward Sheriff's Office will hold a Law Enforcement Trust Fund (LETF) Workshop for non-profit organizations.

LETF money comes from the seizure and forfeiture of contraband that has been used in the commission of a felony, and state law allows BSO to use those funds for the benefit of the community.

Find out if your charitable organization is eligible to receive part of those funds.

The workshop will inform organizations about the qualifying rules and will provide assistance with the application process.

Staff will be available to answer any questions. The deadline for submission of LETF applications is Wednesday, October 19th, 2016 at 11:59 p.m.

We anticipate the County Commission will award the LETF funds in 2017.
